

# Troop 225 Universal Studios - June 28, 2009



**Where:** Universal Studios Orlando

**Departure:** All scouts need to be at the Universal Guest Drop-Off Area by 8:30am. You must arrange your own transportation to get there. The troop will not be providing any transportation to or from this event.

**Meals:** Scouts should bring money to purchase lunch and snacks at Universal Studios.

**Return:** The troop will be done at 5:00pm, and we will walk to the Guest Drop-Off area where scouts can be picked up at the same spot that they were dropped off at. At this time ALL TROOP SUPERVISION WILL END, but scouts will be allowed to stay in the park if we have permission from their parents at drop-off. So, at 5:00 all troop leaders will be leaving and the scout will no longer be with the troop if they choose to stay in the park. Both theme parks are open until 8:00pm and City Walk is open until 2:00am.

**Fee:** \$48 per Scout if you do not have your own season pass. If you do have a season pass then you are expected to pay \$7.

**Due:** No later than Monday, June 1, 2009. (Troop Meeting)

**What:** Scouts will spend the day exploring the Universal Orlando theme park as groups. They will be expected to stay together as groups throughout the entire day.

**Transportation:** Scouts are on their own for securing transportation to and from the Guest Drop-Off Area.

**Equipment:** Scouts MUST wear their Class B uniforms ALL day while at Universal.

**No flip flops are to be worn, water shoes are allowed though. As always, shoes must be closed toe and have a back.**
