Each Scout must bring a Canteen/Water Bottle, pocketknife, Totin’ Chip Card and Fire ‘n Chit Card (look out for a surprise inspection), compass and camp chair. Every Scout should bring a waterproof ground cloth to put under his tent. (An old shower curtain works well for this.) Bring your Troop activity T-shirt for Saturday and as usual no open toe shoes are ever allowed.

NO personal food or electronics (including cell phones).

TROOP TENTS will be used for this Camporee.

REMEMBER: We travel in Field Uniform and PLEASE eat dinner before you arrive.
